

PEACE Zone Recovery Center to Hold One Year Anniversary Open House, March 6, 2014

Evansville, Indiana – February 28, 2014 - Evansville's first and only Recovery Center, PEACE Zone, is excited to announce its one year anniversary open house. PEACE Zone opened February 28, 2013 and is open to the public for an open house on Thursday, March 6, 2014 from 4:30-6:30 pm.

PEACE Zone is peer-run (individuals in recovery are active in running the organization) and assists individuals in recovery from mental health issues through peer support, socialization opportunities, physical wellness, art expression groups, and recovery groups. Anyone struggling with a mental health issue is welcome to visit and become a member. Individuals who come will find a nonjudgmental and supportive atmosphere to work on their recovery. During its first year of operation in 2013, PEACE Zone had over 3,000 visits, and currently has 20-35 daily visitors.

Everyone in the community is welcome to attend the open house. Take a tour, learn about our programs, and meet our staff and volunteers.
