The Indiana Recovery Network, a program of Mental Health America of Indiana, partnered with the Division of Mental Health and Addiction, with support from the Governor's Office of Next Level Recovery to create a statewide Regional Recovery Hub program in 2020. These Hubs connect Hoosiers experiencing substance use and mental health concerns to recovery and other support services.
